**Hydrolysed salmon protein** with a molecular weight <10.000 Dalton has a high digestibility and a low allergenicity.



Rice has a **low allergenicity and a high digestibility**, which makes it a perfect ingredient for hypoallergenic treats. Rice does not contain gluten and will thus be tolerated by dogs with gluten allergy/intolerance.



Very high quality and highly digestible ingredients make the treats especially useful for dogs with small intestinal diarrhoea.

## FEEDING GUIDE IN GRAMS PER DAY
