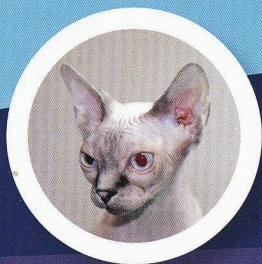
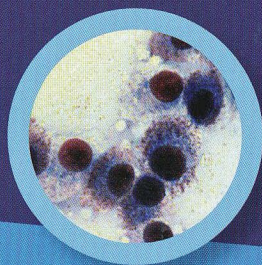


European Society of Veterinary Dermatology
